

Clydebank Canopy

Competition

Our proposal seeks to enliven the existing dreary public space with a new canopy structure to the bridge which creates a landmark. The proposal has a strong silhouette which is instantly recognisable from the surrounding roads and canal. This is further enhanced in the evenings and during the winter by the use of up-lighters, set within the refurbished deck of the existing bridge, to highlight the structure. The proposal forms part of the wider regeneration of Clydebank and seeks to enhance the existing public space to the south of the bridge.

Our proposal addresses issues around sustainability and cost by re-using the columns and foundation structure of the existing canopy. The structure is clad in bright anodised aluminium, which is highly recyclable and requires very little maintenance.

Our proposal creates a memorable place, an event along both the canal and the shopping route, which contributes to the overall regeneration of Clydebank.
