This project consisted of major fabric repairs and stone cleaning to an existing stone tenement in the centre of Edinburgh. It formed part of a programme of general improvements to Cockburn Street, carried out in the 1990s, which involved repairs and stone cleaning to tenements, renewal of shop fronts and major improvements to the streetscape.
